DESCRIPTION:

BRUTE® Insecticide for Horses is a ready-to-use product containing the pyrethroid insecticide permethrin in a non-irritating, oil-based formulation with high residual efficacy against biting flies, gnats, ticks and lice.

EFFECTIVENESS:

BRUTE® Insecticide for Horses controls horn flies for up to 2 weeks and controls biting and nuisance flies, gnats, mosquitoes, ticks and lice on horses.

PACKAGING:

BRUTE® Insecticide for Horses is available in a kit containing one 16 fl. oz. bottle with a convenient 15 ml (1/2 fl. oz.) measuring chamber on top and an applicator mitt.

PRODUCT ADVANTAGES:

1. The most concentrated permethrin product available for horses to assure maximum residual efficacy.
2. Ready-to-use as a Wipe-on or a Pour-on treatment.
3. Controls horn flies for up to 2 weeks and mosquitoes for up to 5 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON HORSES

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wear protective gloves or protective application mitt when using as a wipe-on for horses. Shake well before using. Loosen cap, squeeze bottle to fill measuring chamber with required dosage. Remove cap and apply to animal. **Apply 3-6 ml per 200 lb. body wt. up to a max. of 30 ml. Do not treat foals under 12 weeks of age.**

APPLICATION METHOD	TARGET PEST	APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS
Ready-to-Use Wipe-on (Preferred method for optimum control of most pest species).	For control of mosquitoes, black flies, face flies, horn flies, lice and ticks. Aids in control of stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, bot flies and eye gnats.	Apply as a whole body wipe with cloth or insecticide application mitt. For the first application with a new cloth or mitt, apply twice the dosage to charge the application cloth or mitt. Pay special attention to where pests congregate. • Face flies and eye gnats - apply to face and around eyes, being careful not to get product in the eyes. • Black flies - wipe the inside of the ears, under chin, throat and midline of belly. • Stable flies - wipe legs, lower shoulders and belly. • Bot flies - wipe under chin, throat, chest and legs.
Ready-to-Use Pour-on.	For control of horn flies.	Apply over withers and down back. Do not apply to horses that will be ridden within 24 hours of application. Pour-on application may leave an oily residue on the coat of some animals.

Repeat treatment as needed but not more often than once every 7 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN AND AROUND LIVESTOCK PREMISES

For use in and around livestock premises as a spot treatment. Shake well before using. Loosen cap, squeeze bottle to fill measuring chamber with required dosage. Remove cap and apply.

TARGET INSECTS	APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS
For control of house flies, stable flies and other nuisance pests in and around stables and other livestock premises.	Apply undiluted as a coarse spray or wipe directly to surface where pests crawl and alight. One fl. oz. will treat 560 sq. ft. One pint will treat 8900 sq. ft.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage and Spill Procedures: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
