DESCRIPTION:

Tuttle's SAVOSS® Veterinary Liniment is a penetrating counter-irritant that aids natural healing for fast, temporary relief of minor stiffness, muscle soreness, strains and swelling in leg, shoulder, hip and stifle caused by overexertion, injury or fatigue. Its blend of iodine, herbal extracts and essential oils also provides antiseptic treatment for superficial cuts and abrasions. SAVOSS has been a trusted equine aid since it was developed in 1900.

PACKAGING:

Tuttle's SAVOSS is available in an 8 fluid ounce bottle.

PRODUCT ADVANTAGES:

1. Contains high-quality natural ingredients.
2. Designed to be used full strength for a stronger local effect on affected areas.
3. Contains a counter-irritant property that helps speed the removal of the muscle's waste products that cause soreness and stiffness.
4. Stimulates blood flow to speed nutrients to affected areas and aid recovery from stiffness, soreness and swelling.
5. Works as an antiseptic treatment for superficial cuts and abrasions.
6. Hastens recovery of muscle-related injuries when used with hot and cold packs.
7. May be used to aid reduction of swelling due to bucked shins, bone spavins or splints.
8. Does NOT contain acetone, a chemical that is extremely flammable and can dry the skin by removing natural oils.
9. Is easily applied with the cap-mounted dauber located inside the bottle.



ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Isopropanol 15%

OTHER INGREDIENTS:

Iodine 2% (18 mg/ml), in an aromatic base of Camphor, Turpentine and essential oils of Pine, Cedar, Clove and Wormwood.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Trim hair of affected area and cleanse to ensure liniment penetration. Dry thoroughly. If swollen, see "Use of cold and hot packs".
2. Massage area. Apply SAVOSS full strength with dauber daily for 5 days.
3. Apply a lanolin-based ointment daily for the next 4 days to lessen skin irritation.
4. Reapply SAVOSS and ointment treatments if necessary.

Use of cold and hot packs:

Cold prevents swelling, heat diminishes it. Immediately following a strain or sprain, apply cold continuously for a few days, using ice bags, cold water bandages, cold water whirlpool boots, or cold compresses. Then, before applying SAVOSS, make hot applications for 15 to 20 minutes for the first 3 or 4 days of SAVOSS treatment. Heat can be applied through a soaking tub or hot compresses. For old injuries, use hot applications only. Always dry thoroughly before applying SAVOSS.

CAUTION:

Keep out of the reach of children. Discontinue use if excessive irritation develops. Avoid contact with eyes or mucous membranes. Do not use on horses intended for food.

HOW SAVOSS WORKS:

A good liniment works with nature to restore muscle power. During periods of soreness and stiffness due to strenuous activity, nature responds with heat and swelling. Blood rushes to the area. It's the body's natural repair process.

Applied to the hide over the injury, SAVOSS stimulates even more blood to the trouble spot than nature alone provides. This extra boost in blood circulation helps hasten recovery.

Since you use SAVOSS at full strength, it goes to work fast and often checks stiffness and muscle soreness after the first few applications. And SAVOSS won't blister, scar or remove hair roots when used as directed.

MASSAGE HASTENS HEALING ACTION:

Rub the affected area up and down with the hand, a stiff brush or towel prior to applying SAVOSS. The friction created through massage will stimulate faster blood circulation through the area.

HOW LONG TO USE SAVOSS:

Relief of minor stiffness, soreness or simple swellings should be prompt. A prolonged treatment period may be necessary in extreme situations. Use as long as the circulation stimulation produced by SAVOSS is beneficial.
